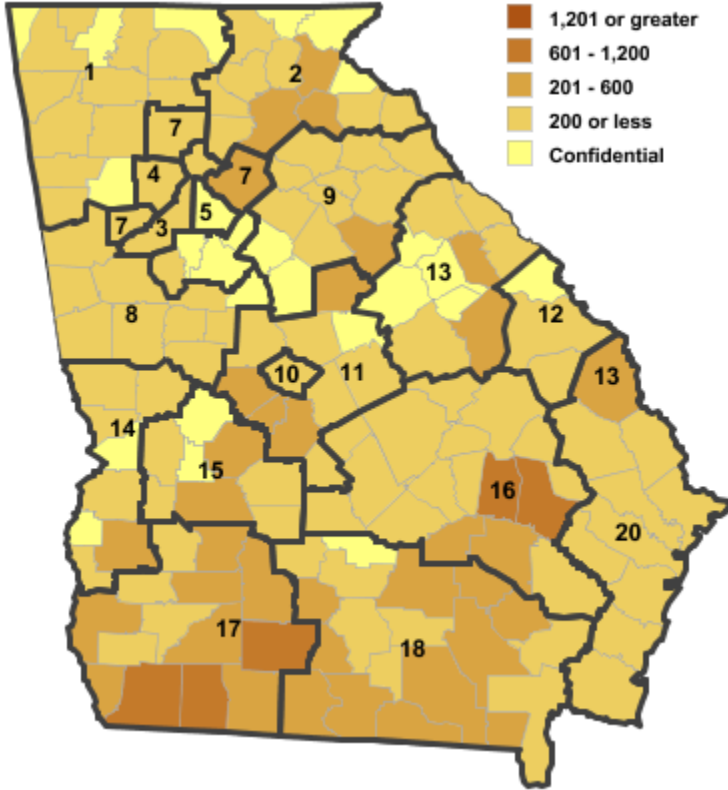


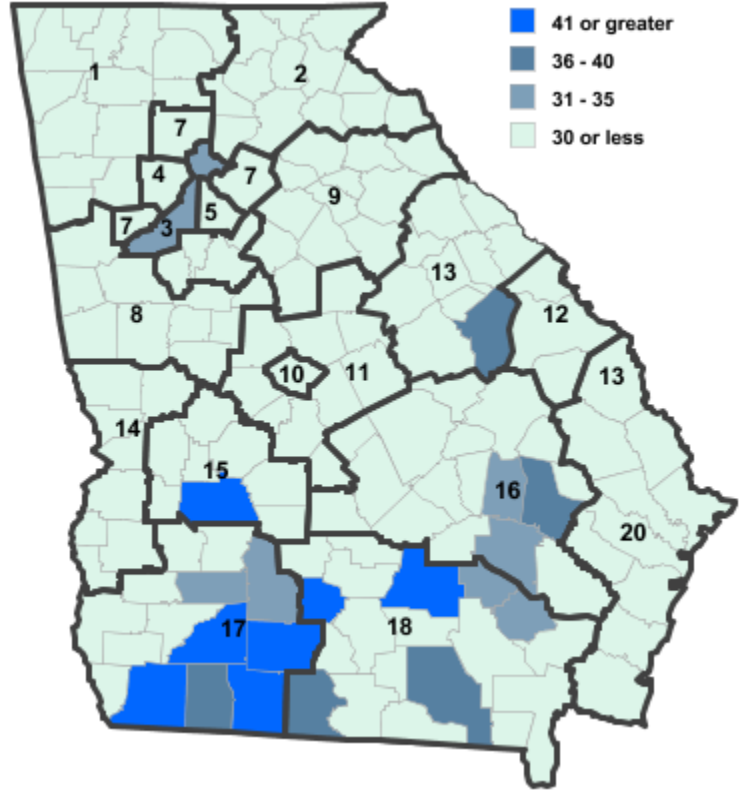

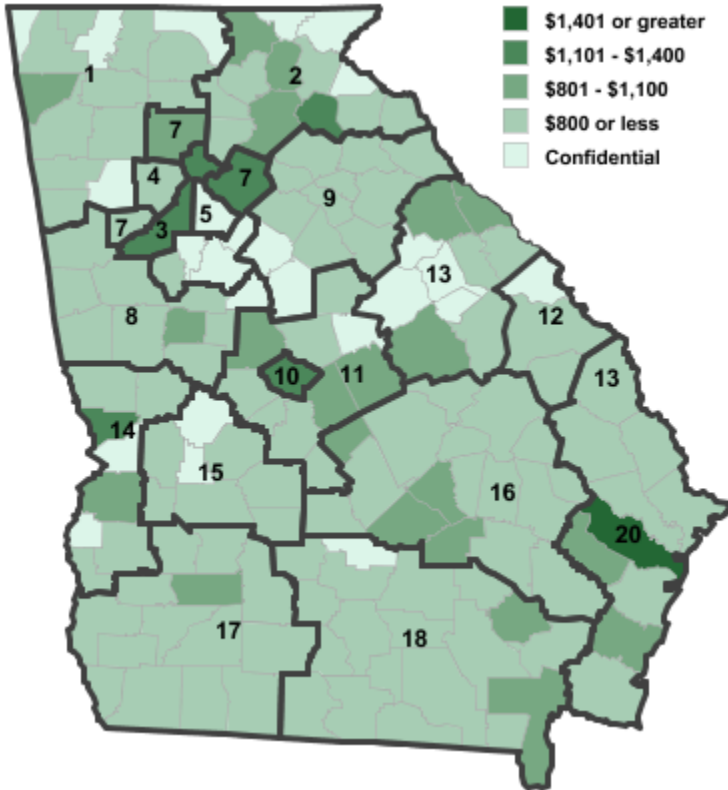
Employment
