


## Fastest Growing Occupations

These fast-growing occupations will have better employment prospects than occupations with slow or declining employment. Also, conditions will be more favorable for mobility and advancement.

Five of the fastest growing occupations are in healthcare and three are computer related.

On a statewide level, four of these occupations have been given the **Hot** label for this period.

Eight of these occupations typically require some postsecondary education or college degree.




## Occupations with the Most Annual Openings

Of the annual openings (1,260) on this list, most will result from the need to replace workers who change jobs (900, 71 percent) rather than from new job creation (360, 29 percent).

Six of these occupations are in the healthcare industry.

Seven occupations generally require some postsecondary education or college degree.


Three occupations have earned the **Hot** label on a statewide level for this period.



# Georgia Area Workforce Trends

## Projections to 2022

### WIA #12 – Central Savannah River




*This area is made up of three counties in east central Georgia in and around the city of Augusta. It includes the counties of Burke, Jenkins, and Richmond.*

## Total Industry Growth

Total employment in Central Savannah River WIA #12 is expected to grow from about 114,000 in 2012 to about 128,000 in 2022, which equates to an average of 1,400 new jobs added each year. The area is the home of a large university and medical college, Fort Gordon Military Base, and the annual Master's Golf Tournament. Key industries are educational services, health services, federal government employment, and chemical manufacturing.


The top ten industries in this area with the most job growth are listed below.



## Industry Rate of Growth

Jobs in WIA #12 – Central Savannah River are expected to grow at a rate of about 1.2 percent per year through 2022. Job growth in the area is below the statewide annual average growth of 1.5 percent and slightly above the national average of 1.1 percent.

The ten fastest growing industries in this area are listed below.

## Occupations with the Most Growth

These 15 occupations – out of more than 800 - are projected to add over 4,600 jobs over the next 10 years, which accounts for almost one-third of the projected job growth in this area.

Five of these jobs typically require some postsecondary education or a college degree.

Four of these occupations are in the healthcare field.

Two of these occupations have made the list of Georgia's **Hot** Careers to 2022 as a result of their fast job growth, high wages, and plentiful job openings.
